There were less children this year that other years, however it went well. There are about 4000 books given to children throughout the year during different programs and events. This year the cost of the books has almost quadrupled, which means that the amount of books given will have to be reduced. Teresa will go through the different programs and decide where the library can cut back to keep within our budget.
